

# Karate Uniform

The karate uniform is called a gi, pronounced “gee”. The gi should be cleaned after every workout. It should only be worn during a workout or while going to or coming from a workout or special events designated by your Sensei. The OKU does not limit the color of gi you should wear. Although, there are some dojos and tournaments which require a *white* only gi be worn for that specific event. White is considered the traditional color. A tee shirt may be worn under the gi.

Below are the acceptable locations for applying the patches according to OKU bylaws. No additional patches or embroidery should be worn without permission from the head of your dojo.
